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INFANT DEDICATION POLICY

Here at First Baptist Church we dedicate babies on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays in each month at all of our services (7:00am and 9:30am). We do not, however, dedicate infants during our special Church services: (e.g. Easter, Christmas, Church Anniversary, Mother's Day, etc). Dedications are scheduled on a first come served basis (that is, first application form in office). Therefore, we advise you to submit and complete your application form as soon as possible to secure your requested date.

Please note the following details:

- A one (1) hour Parental Training Session is MANDATORY for all persons and godparents. Parents and godparents must attend this session on the date given by the Church in order for the child/children to be dedicated. NO INFANT WILL BE DEDICATED IF THE PARENTS AND GODPARENTS DO NOT ATTEND THE PARENTAL TRAINING SESSION.
- Please dress in a manner that is appropriate for the setting. Females are asked to wear comfortably fitting clothing that is not too tight and that adequately covers the chest, back, arms and legs (e.g. no ultra-high minis or plunging necklines). Males are asked to wear a belt with their trousers to avoid sagging.
